Stayed here one night for a show at nearby Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC). Hotel is roughly 15 minutes from the park/venue and 20 minutes from the Racetrack. Traffic during the summer season is pretty bad, so be prepared.

The hotel itself is a Marriott property. I believe this is their bare bones, basic hotel. Rooms were large enough for 2, being basic, you can hear noise. Windows open, which is great for fresh air.
